



Learning Goal

Compare how long or short something is.



What You'll Need

- Paper plate
- Blue yarn or ribbon
- Scissors
- Tape
- Construction paper

Steps



Denotes a step that may require adult support.

- 1. Make a cloud!** Cut a paper plate in half to form a cloud shape.
- 2. Make raindrops!** Use scissors to cut the yarn in 6 different lengths.
- 3. Measure and compare!** Lay the raindrops next to each other to see which pieces are longer and which are shorter.
- 4. Tape!** Choose an order for the raindrops, and tape them to the back of the cloud.
- 5. Decorate the raindrops!** Cut raindrop shapes out of paper and tape one drop to the bottom of each piece of yarn.
