## Learning Goal

Practice counting 1-7.


## What You'll Need

- 7 feathers
- 1 paper plate
- Yarn
- Glue
- Tape
- Markers
- Googly eyes


## Steps

- Plastic kazoo (optional)

1. Make a duck face! Glue seven feathers to the top of the plate. Write the numbers 1 through 7 below the feathers. Draw a

Watch Video triangle beak or cut a triangle and glue it on the plate. Add googly eyes. Now you have a duck face!
2. Make a necklace! Cut a long piece of yarn and knot the ends together to make a yarn necklace. Punch a hole at the top of the plate, among the feathers. Thread a loop of the necklace through the hole, then thread the other end of the necklace through the loop.

3. Practice counting! Wear the duck necklace and practice counting from 1 to 7 by quacking after saying each number. If you have a kazoo, make duck sounds with it! 1, quack, 2, quack ...
