Learning Goals

Explore different kinds of shapes; practice sorting and counting shapes.



What You'll Need

- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Yarn or string
- Markers and crayons
- Hole puncher

Steps

- 1. Make some shapes!** Cut 10 different shapes out of construction paper. Sort them by color, size or type. Think together: How many shapes are in each group?
- 2. Make a necklace!** Punch a hole in the center of each shape and pull the yarn through them all. Tie the ends of the yarn together.
- 3. Show and tell!** Wear your necklace proudly. Count and name the shapes around your neck.
